HURRICANE TRANSPORTATION ISSUES: WHAT TO DO NOW!

If you do not have a vehicle or a way out of town during an evacuation, you need to call 2-1-1 to register with the Galveston County Office of Emergency Management (GCOEM). Galveston County has a "No Fault evacuation policy. They believe no one should stay behind or be left behind when evacuation is called for. The County needs to know ahead of time how many people will need to be evacuated. You must call NOW to register and find out the procedures for evacuating. If you wait until a storm is imminent, they might not have the resources available to assist you.
